

2010 Summer Staff Positions Available

Equestrian & Program Leaders:

Wrangler-In-Training, Red Barn Horse Camp and Overnight Horse Camp Leaders

Plan chapels, schedules, direction/supervision of program, complete daily operations and administrative tasks, interact directly with campers and parents and working closely with counselors and staff. Applicants must be 21 or older with a clean driving record.

Lifeguards: Directly responsible for the safe operation of the camp pool and assist in cleaning. We offer a lifeguard training before camp begins.

Canoe Leader: Responsible for operating the camp canoe program, including water safety, and transporting campers to and from the lake. We will provide lifeguard certification. Must be 21 or older with a CDL and clean driving record.

Counselors:

Head Counselors, Counselors

Through leading, teaching, modeling, sharing and spending maximum time with the campers (including special needs & high needs children), counselors are the key to spiritual growth. The counselor gives direct input into the campers' lives concerning the life-changing message of Jesus Christ and provides safe supervision during the camping experience.

Marketing Intern: Represent Camp Berachah programs at marketing booth during community events, parent programs and Camp Berachah events. Support administration office with marketing duties as assigned. Includes some evenings and weekends.

Program Intern: work under supervision of Program Manager and Associate Director. Specific duties may include planning, interacting with churches, supervision of summer staff, and hosting of guests. Strong leadership, computer and people skills required.

Recreation & Activity Staff: Assist in program implementation by operating camp activities: BB guns, archery, climbing wall, bike rides, go-karts and ropes course. Lifeguard duties for certified applicants. Assist program department with miscellaneous duties as needed.

Medical Staff: Maintain necessary health records, screen campers during registration, coordinate special medical needs with parents. Provide first aid to ensure the health and safety of campers. Must be 21 or older, certified nurse or EMT, and have clean driving record. Assistants will be assigned other tasks during slow parts of the day.

Craft Center: Responsible for leading and planning all camp craft activities.

Nature Center: Responsible to maintain care for all petting zoo animals and equipment including cleaning and feeding. Lead campers in animal learning activities and nature walks.

Equestrian Instructors and Assistant Instructors: Teaching and instruction of equestrian programs to campers, basic horse care, maintain equestrian facility. Must be certified through CHA and at least 18 or older (Age 15 for applicants who have successfully completed the WIT Leadership Training Program).

Special Needs Caregivers: Responsibilities include providing 1 on 1 attention to the camper and making sure that the camper is functioning and being a part of the group.

Food Services/Housekeeping/Facilities at Camp Berachah and Buck Creek: Support Dining Hall, Kitchen, Country store or guest facilities maintenance. Positions are also available at Buck Creek located in Greenwater in the kitchen and facilities departments.
